



There are 3 colour variations of the blanket. In the pattern I will give you the colour numbers to which you will have to change. The sequence will always be pink (Rose Scent)/blue (Sea Breeze)/ green (Morning Dew). But you can always choose your own colours if you wish!

With colour number 1005/1203/1710 make a chain of 201. And we're off!!!!



Row 1

Skip 3 chain stitches (counts as 1 tr). 1 tr in 4th chain from the hook. 1 tr in each following st to end. You now have 199 tr stitches (198 and 1 3-chain stitch). Turn.



Row 2

Ch 2 (counts as 1tr). Skip st at base of 2ch

1tr into each st to end and change colour to 1080/1034/1081. (the last stitch will be made in the 3rd ch of the 3-chain st.

To change colour you must pull the new colour through the last 3 loops on the hook on the last step of the tr.

Row 3

Ch 1 (does not count as a st) (This will be the case for all the dc rows that are to come)
1 dc into st at base of 1 ch. 1dc into each st to end. (199 dc) (the last one will be made in the 2nd ch of the 2-chain stitch.) On the last step of the last st change to colour 1130/1019/1064 by pulling the new colour through the last 2 loops. Turn.



Row 4

In the next 3 rows will be doing granny stripes. A golden oldie, but you definitely want to have it in this blanket. It's just too much fun!

Ch 3 (counts as 1tr), 1 tr in the st at base of 3ch. Skip 2 st. *3 tr into the next st and skip 2 st**. Repeat from * to ** to end. On the final step of the last st change colour to 1218/1722/1420. Turn.



Row 5

Ch 3 in the first stitch. *3 tr in ch sp and repeat to end.

In the last st of the row (the 3rd ch of the 3-chain stitch) make 1 tr and on the final step change back to colour 1130/1019/1064. Turn.



Row 6

In the first stitch ch 3 and 1 tr. *3 tr in ch sp and repeat to end.

In the last st of the row (the 3rd ch of the 3-chain stitch) make 2 tr and on the final step change to colour 1080/1034/1081. Turn.





Row 7

Ch 1 (does not count as a st). 1 dc into st at base of 1 ch. 1 dc into each st to end. (the last one will be made into the 3rd chain of the 3-chain space). On the final step of the last stitch change to colour 1005/1203/1710. Turn.

Row 8

Ch2 (counts as 1tr). Skip st at base of 2 ch. 1tr into each st to end. Turn. (199st)

Row 9

Ch 3 (counts as 1tr). 1 tr into st at base of 3ch. (We have now increased with 1 stitch.) 1tr into each st to end and change colour to 1123/1725/1114 on the final step of the last st. (200 tr) Turn.



Row 10

In this row will be making a cross stitch with double trebles.

Ch 3 (counts as 1 tr) Skip st at base of 3ch.

*Skip 1 st, 1 dtr in next st. Now will be making another dtr in the stitch we just skipped. Yo twice and place the hook behind your last dtr. Place hook in skipped st and finish your dtr. Repeat from * to the last st. In the last st make 1 tr and change to colour 1005/1203/1710 on the final step. Turn.





Row 11

Ch 3 (counts as 1 tr). Skip st at base of 3ch. 1 tr into each st to end. (200 stitches) Turn.

Row 12

Ch 2 (counts as 1 htr). Skip st at base of 2ch. 1 htr into each st to end and on the final step of the last st change colour to 1080/1034/1081. Turn.

Row 13

Ch 1 (does not count as a st) 1 dc into st at base of 1 ch. 1dc into each st to end and change colour to 1065/1316/1027 on the final step of the last st. Turn.



Row 14

Ch 4 (counts as 1 dtr). Skip st at base of 4 ch. 1 dtr into each st to end and change colour to 1080/1034/1081 on the final step of the last st. Turn.



Row 15

Ch 1. (does not count as a st) 1dc into st at base of 1 ch. 1dc into each st to end and on the final step of the last st change colour to 1005/1203/1710. Turn.

Row 16

Ch 2 (counts as 1 htr) Skip st at base of 2 ch. 1 htr into each st to end. Turn.

Row 17

Ch 3 (counts as 1 tr) Skip st at base of 3 ch. 1 tr into each st to end. On the last step of the final st change colour to 1218/1722/1420. Turn.



This was the first week of our CAL. We have made a start! I hope that you can look at your work with a twinkle in your eyes. For me, it is a nice start of a beautiful blanket!
