



There are 3 colour variations of the blanket. In the pattern I will give you the colour numbers to which you will have to change. The sequence will always be pink (Rose Scent) / blue (Sea Breeze) / green (Morning Dew). But you can always choose your own colours if you wish!

The last week of the blanket itself. Time really flies! In week 12 and 13 we'll be making the border, the closing piece of this blanket. Today we will be beginning with the cross stitch. We've done it a few times before, so that should be no problem. I've also made some additional pictures. For more pictures you can check row 10 of week 1.

Row 193

Ch 3 (counts as 1 tr) Skip st at base of 3ch.

*Skip 1 st, 1 dtr in next st. Now will be making another dtr in the stitch we just skipped. Yo twice and place the hook behind your last dtr. Place hook in skipped st and finish your dtr. Repeat from * to the last st. In the last st make 1 tr and change to colour 1005/1203/1710 on the final step. Turn.



Row 194

Ch3 (counts as 1tr) Skip st at base of 3ch. 1tr into each st to end. Turn.

Row 195

Ch2 (counts as 1htr) Skip st at base of 2ch. 1htr into each st to end. On the final step of the last st change colour to 1080/1034/1081. Turn.

Row 196

Ch1 (does not count as a st) 1dc into st at base of 1ch. 1dc into each st to end and on the final step of the last st change colour to 1065/1316/1027. Turn.



Row 197

Ch4 (counts as a dtr) Skip st at base of 4ch. 1dtr into each st to end. On the final step of the last st change colour 1080/1034/1081. Turn.



Row 198

Ch1 (does not count as a st) 1dc into st at base of 1ch. 1dc into each st to end and on the final step of the last st change colour to 1005/1203/1710. Turn.

Row 199

Ch2 (counts as 1htr) Skip st at base of 2ch. 1htr into each st to end. Turn.

Row 200

Ch3 (counts as 1tr) Skip st at base of 3ch. 1tr into each st to the last stitch. Leave this stitch. Bind off.



Row 201

The Wave Stitch is up again.

Attach colour 1218/1722/1420 to the other side of the blanket in the 2nd stitch. So you'll leave the 3ch you began with aside and attach the yarn to the 2nd stitch.

Ch3. *Skip 1 st and make 1tr in the next 3 stitches. Yo, and place the hook before the 3tr in the stitch you just skipped. Yo, and pull it back to position to finish your tr. Finish the treble.** Repeat from * to ** until the last stitch. Make 1 tr. On the last step of the final st change colour to 1005/1203/1710. Turn.



Row 202

Ch 3 (counts as 1 tr). Make 1tr at base of 3 ch. 1 tr into each st to end. Turn.



Row 203

Ch 2 (counts as 1 htr). Skip st at base of 2 ch. 1htr into each st to end. On the last step of the final st change colour to 1080/1034/1081. Turn. You now have 199 stitches.

Row 204

Ch1 (does not count as a st). 1dc into st at base of 1ch. 1dc into each st to end and on the final step of the last st change colour to 1130/1019/1064. Turn.



Row 205

And we're back to our Granny stripes, for the last time! For more pictures, please look at row 4, 5 and 6 of week 1.

Ch 3 (counts as 1tr), 1 tr in the st at base of 3ch. Skip 2 st. *3 tr into the next st and skip 2 st**. Repeat from * to ** to end. On the final step of the last st change colour to 1218/1722/1420. Turn.



Row 206

Ch 3 in the first stitch. *3 tr in ch sp and repeat to end.

In the last st of the row (the 3rd ch of the 3-chain stitch) make 1 tr and on the final step change back to colour 1130/1019/1064. Turn.



Row 207

In the first stitch ch 3 and 1 tr. *3 tr in ch sp and repeat to end.

In the last st of the row (the 3rd ch of the 3-chain stitch) make 2 tr and on the final step change to colour 1080/1034/1081. Turn.



Row 208

Ch 1 (does not count as a st). 1 dc into st at base of 1 ch. 1 dc into each st to end. On the final step of the last stitch change to colour 1005/1203/1710. Turn.

Row 209

Ch2 (counts as 1htr). Make 1 htr in st at base of 2 ch. 1htr into each st to end. Turn. We now finish with 200 stitches.

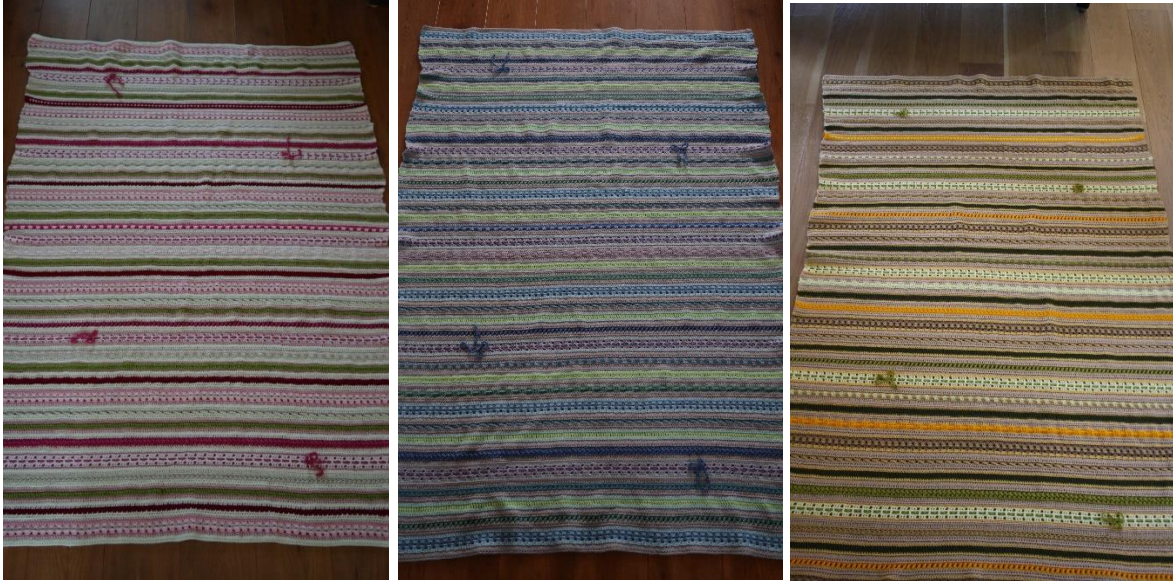


Row 210

Ch 3 (counts as 1tr). Skip st at base of 3ch. 1tr into each st to end.

Bind off and darn in the remaining ends.

The blanket is now ready. Next week we'll begin with the border. What a strange feeling, isn't it?
