

# Pattern week 3

There are 3 colour variations of the blanket. In the pattern I will give you the colour numbers to which you will have to change. The sequence will always be pink (Rose Scent) / blue (Sea Breeze) / green (Morning Dew). But you can always choose your own colours if you wish!

This week we'll begin with a very nice stitch. In the Dutch version of the knitting bible it is called 'the Judith stitch'. Me, I call it 'the Wave', because it gives a very nice wave effect in a jacket I made with it. If all is well, you should start with 198 stitches.

## Row 38

Ch3. \*Skip 1 st and make 1tr in the next 3 stitches. Yo, and place the hook before the 3tr in the stitch you just skipped. Yo, and pull it back to position to finish your tr. Finish the treble.\*\* Repeat from \* to \*\* until the last stitch. Make 1 tr. On the last step of the final st change colour to 1005/1203/1710. Turn.





**Row 39**

Ch 3 (counts as 1 tr). Skip st at base of 3 ch. 1 tr into each st to end. In the last st make another tr, so your stitch count is back on 199 stitches. Turn.

**Row 40**

Ch 2 (counts as 1 htr). Skip st at base of 2 ch. 1htr into each st to end. On the last step of the final st change colour to 1080/1034/1081. Turn.



**Row 41**

Ch1 (does not count as a st). 1dc into st at base of 1ch. 1dc into each st to end and on the final step of the last st change colour to 1130/1019/1064. Turn.



**Row 42**

We are back to the granny stripes! For pictures you can look back to row 4, 5 and 6.

Ch 3 (counts as 1tr), 1 tr in the st at base of 3ch. Skip 2 st. \*3 tr into the next st and skip 2 st\*\*. Repeat from \* to \*\* to end. On the final step of the last st change colour to 1218/1722/1420. Turn.

**Row 43**

Ch 3 in the first stitch. \*3 tr in ch sp and repeat to end.

In the last st of the row (the 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of the 3-chain stitch) make 1 tr and on the final step change back to colour 1130/1019/1064. Turn.

**Row 44**

In the first stitch ch 3 and 1 tr. \*3 tr in ch sp and repeat to end.

In the last st of the row (the 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of the 3-chain stitch) make 2 tr and on the final step change to colour 1080/1034/1081. Turn.

**Row 45**

Ch1 (does not count as a st) 1 dc into st at base of 1ch. 1dc into each st to end and on the final step of the last st change colour to 1005/1203/1710. Turn.

**Row 46**

Ch2 (counts as 1 htr). Skip st at base of 2 ch. 1htr into each st to end. Turn.

**Row 47**

Ch3 (counts as 1 tr), make 1 tr in the st at base of 3ch. (We now made an extra stitch which we'll need for the next row.) 1 tr into each st to end. On the last step of the final st change colour to 1123/1725/1114. Turn.

We now have 200 trebles.



**Row 48**

Relief crochet, it hasn't been that long since I discovered them. I knew them, but I hadn't done anything with them. What a shame! They are so simple with such a pretty effect. Not to be missed in this blanket.

Ch3 (counts as 1 tr). Skip st at base of 3ch. 1tr into each st to end. You now have 200 trebles. Turn.



**Row 49**

Ch3. For the next tr we'll make the treble **around** the treble of the previous row instead of in the stitch on top of the treble of the previous row. Yo, place the hook, on the front, from right to left around the treble. Finish the treble. Make the next 2 trebles the same way. With the next 3 trebles you go around the back. You will also work from right to left around the treble of the previous row. Finish the treble. Repeat this to the end of the row. Make 3 trebles around the front, and then make 3 trebles around the back.

At the end of the row you will have 1 st left. Here you'll make a normal treble. On the last step fo the final st change colour to 1005/1203/1710. Turn.



**Row 50**

Ch3 (counts as 1 tr). Skip st at base of 3ch. 1 tr into each st to end. Turn.

**Row 51**

Ch2 (counts as 1 htr). Skip st at base of 2ch. 1 htr into each st to end and on the final step of the last st change colour to 1080/1034/1081. Turn.

**Row 52**

Ch1 (does not count as a st). 1dc into st at base of 1ch. 1dc into each st to end and on the final step of the last st change colour to 1065/1316/1027. Turn.



**Row 53**

Ch4 (counts as 1dtr). Skip st at base of 4ch. 1dtr into each st to end. On the last step of the final st change colour to 1080/1034/1081. Turn.

**Row 54**

Ch1 (does not count as a st). 1dc into st at base of 1ch. 1dc into each st to end and on the final step of the last st change colour to 1005/1203/1710. Turn.

**Row 55**

Ch2 (counts as 1 htr). Skip st at base of 2ch. 1 htr into each st to end. Turn.

**Row 56**

Ch3 (counts as 1 tr). Skip st at base of 3ch. 1 tr into each st to end. On the final step of the last st change colour to 1218/1722/1420. Turn.

Do you still have 200 stitches?
