



There are 3 colour variations of the blanket. In the pattern I will give you the colour numbers to which you will have to change. The sequence will always be pink (Rose Scent) / blue (Sea Breeze) / green (Morning Dew). But you can always choose your own colours if you wish!

We'll begin at a nice calm pace. The double trebles.

Row 133

And we're off!! Ch4 (counts as a dtr) Skip st at base of 4ch. 1dtr into each st to end. On the final step of the last st change colour 1080/1034/1081. Turn.



Row 134

Ch1 (does not count as a st) 1dc into st at base of 1ch. 1dc into each st to end and on the final step of the last st change colour to 1005/1203/1710. Turn.

Row 135

Ch2 (counts as a htr) Skip st at base of 2ch. 1htr into each st to end. Turn.

Row 136

Ch3 (counts as a tr) Skip st at base of 3ch. 1tr into each st to end. On the final step of the last st change colour to 1218/1722/1420. Turn.



Relief trebles. A nice stitch on and off.

Row 137

Ch3 (counts as 1 tr). Skip st at base of 3ch. 1tr into each st to end. You now have 200 trebles. Turn.



Row 138

Ch3. For the next tr we'll make the treble **around** the treble of the previous row instead of in the stitch on top of the treble of the previous row. Yo, place the hook, on the front, from right to left around the treble. Finish the treble. Make the next 2 trebles the same way. With the next 3 trebles you go around the back. You will also work from right to left around the treble of the previous row. Finish the treble. Repeat this to the end of the row. Make 3 trebles around the front, and then make 3 trebles around the back.

At the end of the row you will have 1 st left. Here you'll make a normal treble. On the last step fo the final st change colour to 1005/1203/1710. Turn.



Row 139

Ch3 (does not count as a st) Skip st at base of 3ch. 1 tr into each st to end. Turn.

Row 140

Ch2 (does not count as a st) Skip st at base of 2ch. 1htr into each st to end. On the final step of the last st change colour to 1080/1034/1081. Turn.

Row 141

Ch1 (does not count as a st) 1dc into st at base of 1ch. 1dc into each st to the last st. Leave this stitch. On the final step of the last st change colour to 1240/1724/1020. Turn.

Row 142


We're back to our filet crochet. For pictures of the next 3 rows you can look at rows 23, 24 and 25 of week 2.

Ch 3. (Counts as 1 tr) Ch 1 tr in the 2nd and 3rd st of the row. *Ch 1, skip 1 st, make 1 tr in the next 3 stitches**. Repeat from * to ** to the end of the row. Turn.



Row 143

Ch 4 (counts as 1 tr and 1 ch), skip the stitch at the base of 4 ch, and the next st. 1 tr in the 3rd stitch. *ch1, skip 1ch st of the previous row, 1 tr. Ch 1, skip 1 st and make 1 tr in the next st.** Repeat from * to ** to the end of the row. Turn.



Row 144

Ch3. Make 1tr in the 1st ch space. Make 1tr. *Ch1, skip 1 ch st and make 1 tr in the next st. Make 1 tr in the next ch space. Make 1 tr in the next st.** Repeat from * to ** the end of the row and on the last step of the final st change colour to 1080/1034/1081. Turn. (Leave work aside)



Now take colour 1023/1302/1712 and chain 185 stitches. Bind off.
Make another of 90 chain stitches. Bind off.

String the cords through the middle row of the filet stitches as you did the first time. So the bows will be alternately on the left and on the right.



Row 145

Pick up your work again. Ch 1. Make 1 dc in the next 3 stitches. Make 1 dc in each ch space and in all the st until the end of the row. On the last step of the final st change to colour 1005/1203/1710. Turn.

Row 146

Ch 2 (counts as 1 htr). Skip st at base of 2ch. 1 htr into each st to end. Turn.

Row 147

Ch 3 (counts as 1 tr). Make another tr in st at base of 3ch. 1 tr into each st to end. On the last step of the final st change colour to 1023/1302/1712. Turn.



Row 148

And we're going to crochet some more wings!

Ch3. In the next 2nd and 3rd st, make 2 htr tog. So you do a yo, put the hook in the 2nd stitch and pull through the yarn. Now you'll do another yo, put the hook in the 3rd stitch and pull through a new loop. To finish the stitch, you do another yo, and pull a loop through all the 5 loops on the hook. Make a tr in the same st as the last.


*In the next 2 stitches make 2htr tog as you just did. In the same st you also make 1 tr.**
Repeat from * to ** to the end of the row.



Row 149

Ch 3. In the 1st and 2nd st make 2 htr tog. Do this also in the 3rd and 4th stitch. Now we'll crochet some treble, but not in the normal way. You do a yo and put the hook in between the 2htr you crocheted together and the previous tr to the right of the previous row. You do a yo and pull a loop through. You make sure you get to the height of your current row and finish the stitch. *In the next 2st you make another 2htr tog. In the next stitch you do again a special tr. (down to the right, in between the 2htr tog and the previous tr.**

Repeat from * to ** to the end of the row. You end the row with a tr in the 3rd ch st of the 3ch st of which you began the last row. On the last step of the final st change colour to 1005/1203/1710. Turn.



Row 150

Ch3 (counts as 1 tr) Skip st at base of 3ch. 1 tr into each st to end. Turn.

If all is well, you should still have 199.

Row 151

Ch2 (counts as 1 htr). Skip st at base of 2ch. 1htr in each st to end. On the last step of the final st change colour to 1080/1034/1081. Turn.

Row 152

Ch1 (does not count as a st). 1dc into st at base of 1ch. 1dc in each st to end and on the final step of the last st change colour to 1065/1316/1027. Turn.



Now it should look warm and cozy. We'll continue next week.
