



There are 3 colour variations of the blanket. In the pattern I will give you the colour numbers to which you will have to change. The sequence will always be pink (Rose Scent) / blue (Sea Breeze) / green (Morning Dew). But you can always choose your own colours if you wish!

Three times is a charm! This week as well, we'll begin with the double trebles. This long legged lady walks side by side with us along this blanket.



Row 153

Ch4 (counts as a dtr) Skip st at base of 4ch. 1dtr into each st to end. On the final step of the last st change colour 1080/1034/1081. Turn.

Row 154

Ch1 (does not count as a st) 1dc into st at base of 1ch. 1dc into each st to end and on the final step of the last st change colour to 1005/1203/1710. Turn.



Row 155

Ch2 (counts as a htr) Skip st at base of 2ch. 1htr into each st to end. Turn.

Row 156

Ch3 (counts as a tr) 1tr in st at base of 3ch. 1tr into each st to end. On the final step of the last st change colour to 1218/1722/1420. Turn. You now have 200 stitches.



We're going to crochet some more crow feet. A nice stitch to make and a fun one to watch. While I'm making this stitch, I can't help but smile as it reminds me on the little crow feet next to my eyes.

Row 157

Ch1 (does not count as a st). 1dc into st at base of 1ch. 1dc into each st to end and on the final step of the last st change colour to 1240/1724/1020. Turn.



Row 158

Ch3 (counts as 1 tr). Skip st at base of 3ch. 1 tr in 2nd and 3rd st. *Ch2, skip 2 stitches, 1tr in next 2 stitches.** Repeat from * to ** to the last stitch. Make 1 tr. Turn.



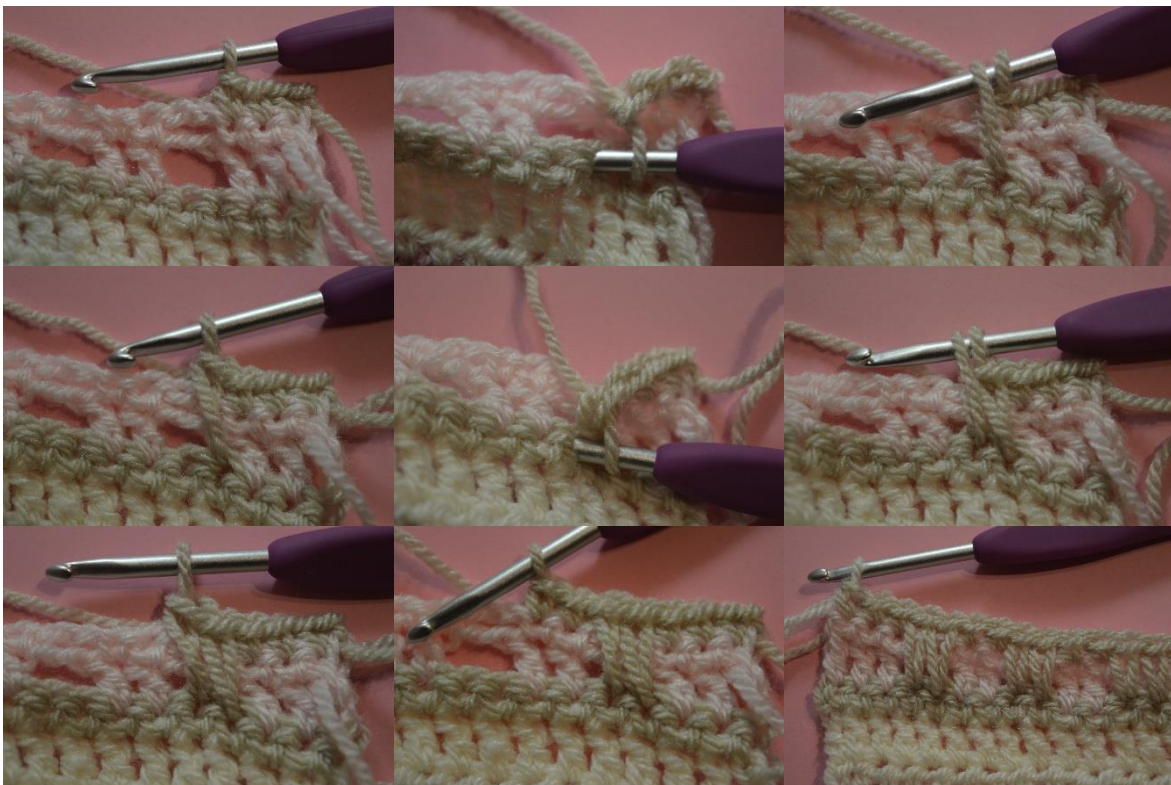
Row 159

Ch1 (does not count as a st). 1 dc into st at base of 1 ch. 1dc in 2nd and 3rd st. *Ch2, skip the 2 ch space of the previous row, 1dc in the next 2 stitches.** Repeat from * to ** to the last stitch. Make 1 dc. On the last step of the final st change colour to 1218/1722/1420. Turn.



Row 160

Ch1 (does not count as a st) 1dc into st at base of 1ch. 1dc in 2nd and 3rd st. *Make 1 dc, but you must put your hook in the stitch that lies below the 2 2ch spaces. Pull a loop and place the hook back on the height of the current row. Finish the dc. Repeat this for the next stitch. In the next 2 stitches make 1 dc.** Repeat from * to ** to the last stitch. Make 1 dc. On the last step of the final st change colour to 1005/1203/1710. Turn.



Row 161

Ch3 (counts as 1 tr). Skip st at base of 3ch. 1 tr into each st to end.

Row 162

Ch2 (counts as 1 htr). Skip st at base of 2ch. 1 htr into each st to end. On the last step of the final st change colour to 1080/1034/1081. Turn.

Row 163

Ch1 (does not count as a st). 1dc into st at base of 1ch. 1dc into each st to the last st. Leave the last stitch. (2ch) You now have 199 stitches. On the last step of the final st change colour to 1130/1019/1064. Turn.



Row 164

And we're back to our Granny stripes!

Ch 3 (counts as 1tr), 1 tr in the st at base of 3ch. Skip 2 st. *3 tr into the next st and skip 2 st**. Repeat from * to ** to end. On the final step of the last st change colour to 1218/1722/1420. Turn.



Row 165

Ch 3 in the first stitch. *3 tr in ch sp and repeat to end.

In the last st of the row (the 3rd ch of the 3-chain stitch) make 1 tr and on the final step change back to colour 1130/1019/1064. Turn.



Row 166

In the first stitch ch 3 and 1 tr. *3 tr in ch sp and repeat to end.

In the last st of the row (the 3rd ch of the 3-chain stitch) make 2 tr and on the final step change to colour 1080/1034/1081. Turn.



Row 167

Ch 1 (does not count as a st). 1 dc into st at base of 1 ch. 1 dc into each st to end. On the final step of the last stitch change to colour 1005/1203/1710. Turn.

Row 168

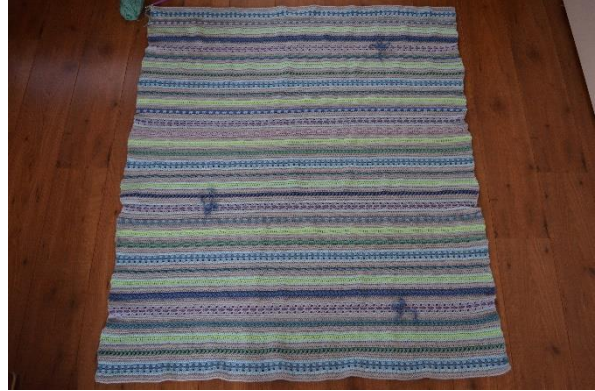
Ch2 (counts as 1tr). Make 1 htr in st at base of 2 ch. 1htr into each st to end. Turn.

Row 169

Ch 3 (counts as 1tr). Skip st at base of 3ch. 1tr into each st to end. On the final step of the last st change colour to 1123/1725/1114. Turn. If all is well you'd still have 199 stitches.



This was the last row of this week already. We'll continue on Friday!
2 more weeks and then the blanket will be ready. We're going fast, aren't we?
