

Pattern Gauge Swatch CAL

My gauge swatch is 10x10 cm. (2.5x2.5 inch) I've made it from trebles. This is a good height for a stitch.

I needed 16 stitches and 9 rows for this swatch.

Start with a chain of 18 stitches. You'll make your first treble in the 4th chain stitch of your hook.

After that you'll make a treble in the next 14 stitches.

For the next rows, you turn, chain 3, and then make treble in the next stitch (you slip the stitch at the base of the 3-chain).

If your swatch is smaller than 10x10 cm, you should use a bigger hook. If it is bigger, than 10x10 you should use a smaller hook.

Keep adjusting the hook size until it measures 10x10 cm, and you'll know which hook you should be using for the CAL.
