



We're starting week 9 with 198 stitches on the row. Because the stitches of this week are the same ones as in week 5 I've decided to leave out the pictures, as not to spoil too much ink for those who print out the pattern.

Last week we didn't change colour yet, so at the end of row 180 change colour to 1009/1064/1099/1080. And happy crocheting for this week as well!

Row 181

Chain 1 (does not count as a stitch). Make 1 htr in the 2nd stitch and in every stitch to the end. During the last step of the last htr, change colour 1065/1130/1422/1081. In this row we've decreased 1 stitch. You now have 197 stitches. The chain stitch on the 1st stitch we'll be leaving it as it is. The 1st htr in the 2nd stitch will be your last stitch of the next row.

Row 182

Chain 2 (does not count as a stitch). Make 1 tr in the 1st stitch and in every stitch to the last stitch. During the last step of the last tr, change colour 1724/1005/1203/2010.

Row 183

Chain 3 (does **not** count as a stitch). Make 1 dtr in the 1st stitch and in every stitch to the last stitch. During the last step of the last dtr, change colour 1432/1004/2012/1302. Leave the 2-ch starting chain, you won't be using them.

Row 184

Chain 1 (does not count as a stitch). Make 1 dc in the 1st stitch and in every stitch to the end. Fasten off.

Row 185

Attach colour 1277/2010/1034/1820 in the first stitch of the other side of the row you just ended on.

Chain 3 (does count as a stitch). Make 1 tr in the 2nd stitch and in every stitch to the end.

Row 186

Chain 3 (counts as the 1st treble). Make 1 treble around each 3 next trebles of the last row. You begin with 3 relief trebles on the front and then 3 at the back. Continue until you have 1

stitch left. You end with 3 relief trebles on the front. In the last stitch, end with a normal treble in the 3rd stitch of the 3-chain of the last row.

For more information regarding this stitch and extra pictures, look at row 2.

Row 187

Chain 3 (counts as the 1st treble). Make 1 treble around the next 3 trebles of the last round. This row is basically the same as the last row, but then the other way around. You now start with 3 relief trebles on the back and then 3 relief trebles on the front. Continue until the last stitch. The last 3 relief trebles will be at the back. The last stitch of the row is a normal treble in the 3rd stitch of the 3-chain of the last row.

Row 188

Chain 3 (counts as the 1st treble). Make 1 treble around the next 3 trebles of the last round. Start again with 3 relief trebles on the front and then 3 relief trebles on the back. Continue until the last stitch. The last 3 relief trebles will be at the front. The last stitch of the row is a normal treble in the 3rd stitch of the 3-chain of the last row.

Row 189 to 192

Keep repeating row 187 and 188. At the last step of the last tr of row 97 change to colour 1432/1004/2012/1302.

Row 193

Chain 1 (does not count as a stitch). Make 1 dc in the 1st stitch and in every stitch to the end. During the last step of the last dc, change colour 1724/1005/1203/2010.

Row 194

Chain 3 (does **not** count as a stitch). Make 1 dtr in the 1st stitch and in every stitch to the last stitch. During the last step of the last dtr, change colour 1065/1130/1422/1081.

Row 195

Chain 2 (does not count as a stitch). Make 1 tr in the 1st stitch and in every stitch to the last stitch. During the last step of the last tr, change colour 1009/1064/1099/1080.

Row 196

Chain 1 (does not count as a stitch). Make 2 htr in the 1st stitch. Make 1 htr in the 2nd stitch and in every stitch to the end. You are now back at 198 stitches. The colour change will be announced next week.





This was it for this week. This week, just like in week 5, was a lovely week with calming stitches for a balanced blanket.
