



Week 10! We are going so fast! Are you feeling up to it?? Also in this week we'll be crocheting quite some stitches on the blanket. We are starting this week with 198 stitches on the row.

At the end of row 196 change colour to 1432/1004/2012/1302.

Row 197

Chain 1 (does not count as a stitch). Make 1 dc in the 1st stitch and in every stitch to the end. Fasten off.

Row 198

The **Pearl stitch** is up again. Attach colour 1822/1080/2018/1083 in the first stitch of the other side of the row you just ended on.

Chain 3 (counts as your 1st treble). In the next stitch (the 2nd) make another treble. Around this treble you will make a 'pearl'. For this, do a yo and place your hook behind the treble you just made. Do another yo and pick it up. Repeat this 2 more times. You now have 7 loops on your hook. Do another yo and pull it through the first 6 loops on your hook. Make a final yo and pull it through the final 2 loops. You made your first 'pearl'! Skip 1 stitch, and in the next stitch make 1 treble. *Make a 'pearl' around this treble. Skip 1 stitch and in the next stitch make 1 treble.** Repeat from * to ** to the end of the row. And the end, fasten off.

Row 199

Attach colour 1432/1004/2012/1302 in the first stitch of the other side of the row you just ended on. (3-chain starting chain)

Chain 1 (does not count as a stitch). Make 1 dc in the 1st stitch and in every stitch to the end. During the last step of the last dc, change colour 1009/1064/1099/1080.

Row 200

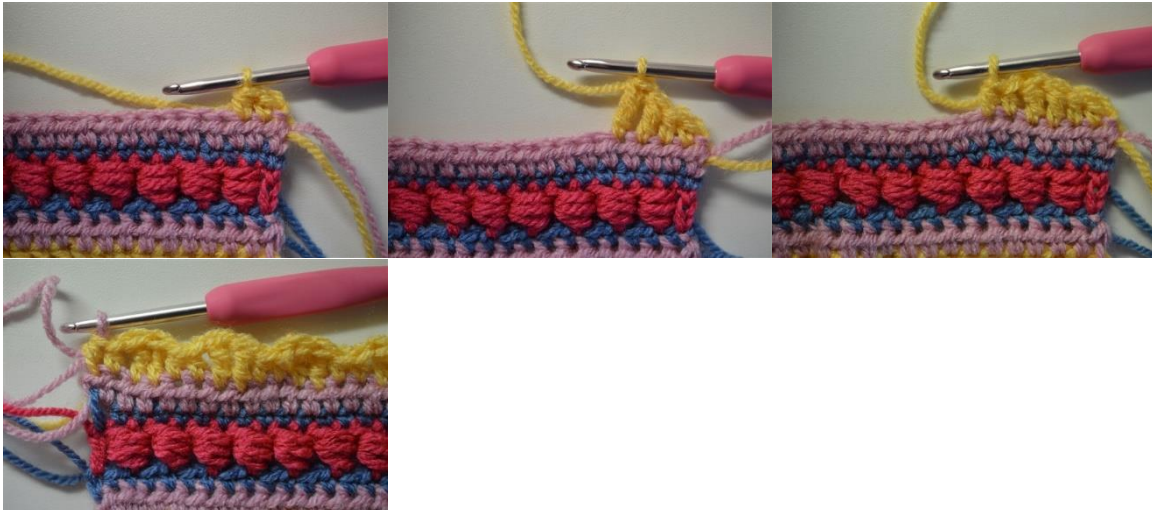
Chain 1 (does not count as a stitch). Make 1 htr in the 1st stitch and in every stitch to the end. During the last step of the last htr, change colour 1065/1130/1422/1081.



Row 201

The stitch we are going to crochet now doesn't really have a name. It's a mix between dtr and htr. I used in my blanket 'Janette' and I liked the wave movement so much that I wanted to use it in this Cal as well.

Chain 1 (does not count as a stitch). Make 1 htr in the 1st and 2nd stitch. *In the next 2 stitches make 1dtr and in the next 2 stitches after make 1 htr.** Repeat from * to ** to the end of the row. On the last step of the last htr change colour to 1009/1064/1099/1080.



Row 202

Chain 1 (does not count as a stitch). Make 1 htr in the 1st stitch and in every stitch to the end. In the last stitch make another htr. This way you have the 199 stitches you need for the next row. During the last step of the last htr, change colour 1277/2010/1034/1820.



Row 203

For pictures of the next 5 rows you can look at row 75 to 79.

We will be making the **Granny stripes** again.

Ch 3 (counts as 1 tr) and 1 tr in the st at base of 3ch. Skip 2 st. *make 3 tr into the next stitches and skip the next 2 stitches**. Repeat from * to ** to the end of the row. In the last stitch make an additional 2 tr. On the final step of the last st change colour to 1724/1005/1203/2010.

Row 204

Ch 3 in the first stitch. (counts as 1 tr) *In the chain space after the 2 tr of the last round make 3 tr. In every opening between 2 groups of 3 tr make 3 tr and repeat this to the end. In the last st of the row (the 3rd ch of the 3-chain stitch) make 1 tr and on the final step change back to colour 1277/2010/1034/1820.

Row 205

Ch 3 (counts as 1 tr) and 1 tr in the st at base of 3ch. In the chain space after the 3 tr of the last round make 3 tr. In every opening between 2 groups of 3 tr make 3 tr and repeat this to the end. In the last stitch (the 3rd ch of the 3-chain stitch) end with 2 tr. On the final step of the last st change colour to 1724/1005/1203/2010.

Row 206

Ch 3 in the first stitch. (counts as 1 tr) *In the chain space after the 2 tr of the last round make 3 tr. In every opening between 2 groups of 3 tr make 3 tr and repeat this to the end. In the last st of the row (the 3rd ch of the 3-chain stitch) make 1 tr and on the final step change back to colour 1277/2010/1034/1820.

Row 207

Ch 3 (counts as 1 tr) and 1 tr in the st at base of 3ch. In the chain space after the 3 tr of the last round make 3 tr. In every opening between 2 groups of 3 tr make 3 tr and repeat this to the end. In the last stitch (the 3rd ch of the 3-chain stitch) end with 2 tr. On the final step of the last st change colour to 1009/1064/1099/1080.

Row 208

Chain 1 (does not count as a stitch). Make 1 htr in the 1st stitch and in every stitch to the end. During the last step of the last htr, change colour 1065/1130/1422/1081.



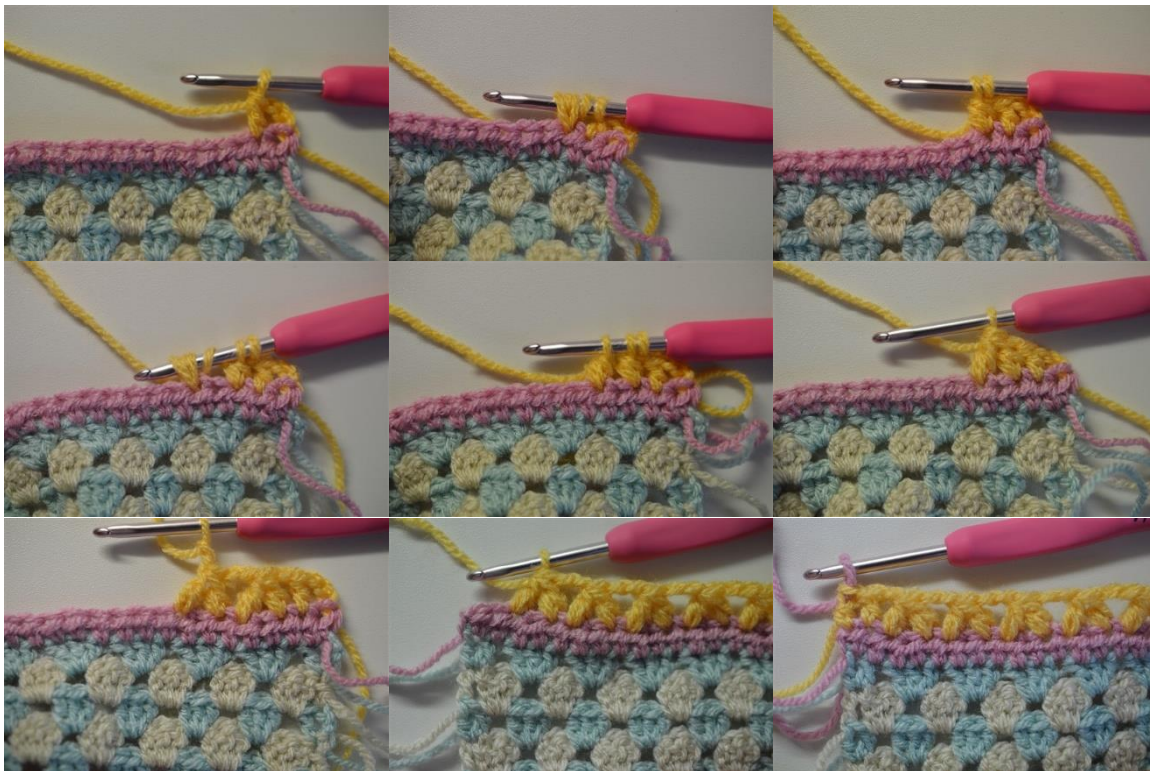
Row 209

The **Forked Clusters** are up again.

Chain 3 (counts as your first treble). Make a tr in the 2nd stitch.

Chain 1. Make a yo and put your hook in the 3rd stitch. Do another yo and pull up a loop. Do another yo and put your hook in the same stitch. Do another yo and pull up a loop. You now have 5 loops on your hook. Do a next yo and pull the thread through the first 4 loops. Make a yo, skip 1 stitch and put your hook in the stitch after that skipped one. Do a yo and pull up a loop. Do a yo and put it back in the same stitch. Do another yo and pull up a loop. You now have 6 loops on your hook. Do a yo and pull the thread through the first 4 loops. Do another yo and pull the thread through the last 3 loops on your hook.

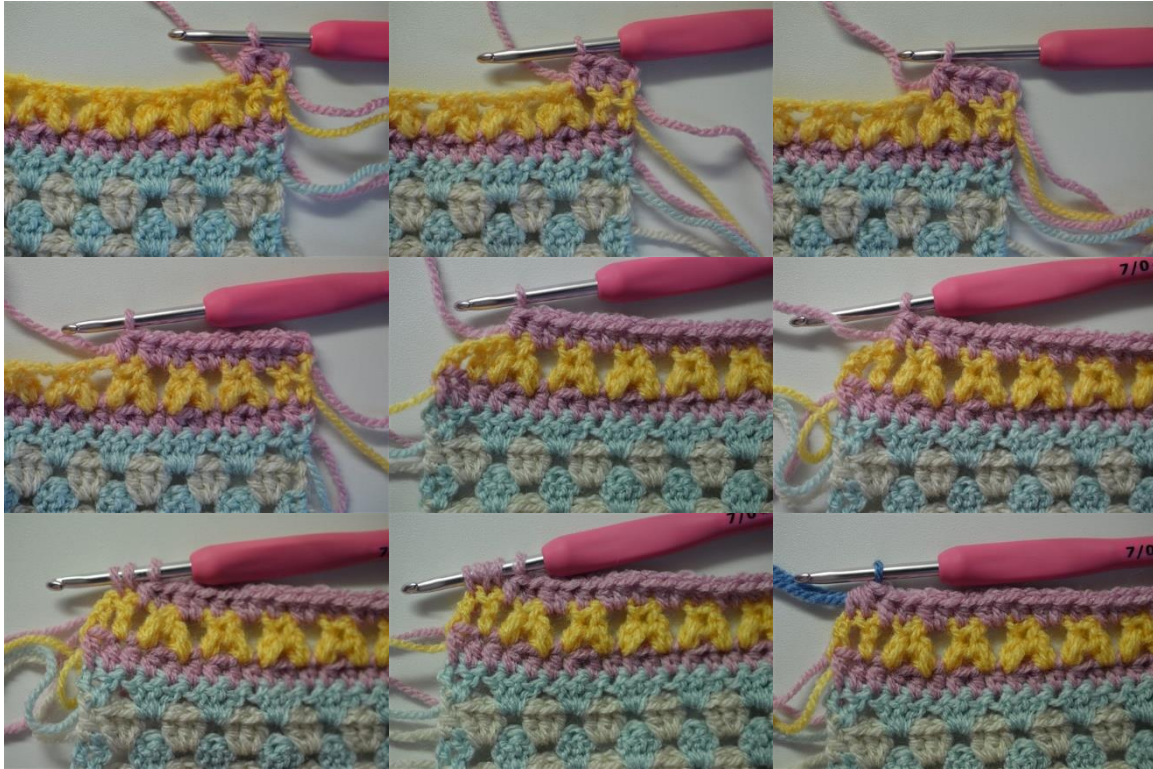
*Chain 2. Make a yo and put your hook in the next stitch. Do another yo and pull up a loop. Do another yo and put your hook in the same stitch. Do another yo and pull up a loop. You now have 5 loops on your hook. Do a next yo and pull the thread through the first 4 loops. Make a yo, skip 1 stitch and put your hook in the stitch after that skipped one. Do a yo and pull up a loop. Do a yo and put it back in the same stitch. Do another yo and pull up a loop. You now have 6 loops on your hook. Do a yo and pull the thread through the first 4 loops. Do another yo and pull the thread through the last 3 loops on your hook.** Repeat from * to ** until the last 2 stitches. Chain 1 and make a tr in the last 2 stitches. On the last step of the last tr change colour to 1009/1064/1099/1080.



Row 210

Chain 1 (does not count as your first stitch). In the 1st and 2nd stitch make 1 htr. Make 1 htr in the 1-ch space. Make a htr in the next stitch. From here on, make 2 htr in every 2-ch space and 1 htr in every stitch between the 2-ch spaces. Do this until you've reached the 'cluster'. Here, make another htr around the 1-ch space. In the last 2 stitches of this row make 2 htr tog. For this, make a yo and put the hook on the 2nd last stitch. Do another yo and pick up a thread. Do

another yo and place the hook in the last stitch (the 3rd chain of the 3-ch starting chain). Do another yo and pick up the thread. You now have 5 loops on your hook. Change to colour 1432/1004/2012/1302 and pull the new colour through all 5 loops. You are now back at 198 stitches.



Row 211

Chain 1 (does not count as a stitch). Make 1 dc in the 1st stitch and in every stitch to the end. Fasten off.

Row 212

The **Pearl stitch** is up again. Attach colour 1822/1080/2018/1083 in the first stitch of the other side of the row you just ended on.

Chain 3 (counts as your 1st treble). In the next stitch (the 2nd) make another treble. Around this treble you will make a 'pearl'. For this, do a yo and place your hook behind the treble you just made. Do another yo and pick it up. Repeat this 2 more times. You now have 7 loops on your hook. Do another yo and pull it through the first 6 loops on your hook. Make a final yo and pull it through the final 2 loops. You made your first 'pearl'! Skip 1 stitch, and in the next stitch make 1 treble. *Make a 'pearl' around this treble. Skip 1 stitch and in the next stitch make 1 treble.** Repeat from * to ** to the end of the row. And the end, fasten off.

Row 213

Attach colour 1432/1004/2012/1302 in the first stitch of the other side of the row you just ended on. (3-chain starting chain)

Chain 1 (does not count as a stitch). Make 1 dc in the 1st stitch and in every stitch to the end. Next week I will give you the next colour change!



That was it for this week! Next week we move on. Wow, your blanket is getting nice!! You do agree with me, don't you?
